IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT RETURNING TO SCHOOL

MONDAY 8th MARCH 2021

We hope that you and your families are all safe and well. Following the Prime Minister's announcement, we are pleased to confirm that primary schools will re-open on Monday 8th March 2021 to all children. To ensure a smooth return we are providing parents/carers with the following important reminders:

The school will continue staggered start and finish times to allow for social distancing. We are asking that parents/carers adhere to these start and finish times.

Nursery	8:30am –	11:30am – Orange Class
Nursery	12:30pm –	3:30pm – Plum Class
Y1, 3 & 5	8:40 am –	3:00 pm
Y2, 4 & 6	8:50 am –	3:10 pm
Reception	9.00 am –	3.20 pm

Families with children starting school at different times, may drop off their younger children at the same time as their older children, as teachers will be in classrooms.

- To reduce the spread of COVID-19 there **must be only ONE parent/carer entering the school** site at pick up and drop off times. Parent/Carers should avoid congregating on the school site or by the school entrance. You are asked to drop off/collect your child/children and then promptly leave the school site.
- **Children in Y4, Y5 and Y6** will be expected to enter the school gates and make their own way to their classrooms. We will have members of staff at key points to ensure all children move quickly to their classes.
- **As with all supermarkets and public places, all adults must wear a face mask or suitable face covering at all times when on the school site** unless there is a medical reason that prohibits you wearing one. You are advised to wear a face visor instead, if you are unable to wear a face mask or covering. All adults entering the site are expected to provide their own face coverings, as the school may not have the capacity to supply them.
- Whilst at school, children will be hand washing/hand sanitizing throughout the day. These include on arrival to school; when returning from breaks; when changing rooms; before and after eating and at the end of the day.
- Parent/carers collecting children at the end of the day must observe social distancing and ensure they stand outside the white boxes, marked on the ground, outside classrooms. Each year group will be dismissed at their finish time only. Parent/Carers may wait in the KS1 playground to collect children finishing at later times.

- Children should come to school dressed in their PE kits on the days that they have PE. They will remain in their PE kits for the day. Days for PE have not changed. Please ask your child's teacher or the school office if you are unsure of the days.
- Children must only bring a water bottle and packed lunch box to school, if they are not having school meals. Please ensure these are clearly marked with your child's name.
- If your child is travelling to school on public transport and will be wearing a face mask, please ensure that they have a small plastic bag to put their face mask into before entering the school site.

- **Please ensure that your contact details for parent/carers are up to date.** If you have recently changed any details, please contact the school office.

Reporting a positive case of COVID-19

- If your child has a high temperature, persistent cough, a loss of taste/smell or any other Covid-19 symptoms, you must keep them at home until they have taken a Covid-19 test. You must report your child's absence by calling 0208 997 0619 option 1, leaving a message with brief details of why your child will not be at school. When you receive the results of the Covid 19 test, whether positive or negative, please inform the school of the outcome by sending an email to covid19@perivale.ealing.sch.uk.
- If any member of your household develops symptoms of Covid-19, they must self isolate and arrange for a test. Your child will also have to self isolate for 14 days or until a negative test result is returned. Again, you should report your child's absence to school and provide details of the reason.

A member of school staff will contact you to discuss when your child can return to school.

Parking Reminder

- **Ealing School Street Scheme reminder** Parts of Perimeade, Federal, Fraser and Sarsfield Roads will be closed to traffic between **8.15-9.15am and 2.45-3.45pm, Monday to Friday during term time**. Enforcement will be via ANPR camera. Parents will not be allowed to drive down the above-named roads between these hours without a permit. Driving through the scheme during operational hours will result in vehicles being issued with a Penalty Charge Notice.
