8.30am - main gates to school open

Nursery (Morning) 8.30am - 11.30am

Nursery (Afternoon) 12.30pm - 3.30pm

Classes in Reception to Y6:

8.40am - Gate to KS1/KS2 playground open

8.50am - Lessons begin

The car park to playground gate will be locked at 8.50am. Any child arriving at school after this time should enter the school via the school office. They will be issued with a late card and escorted to their classes.

Children in Y1, Y2, Y3 & Y4 will still enter the school via the end of their phase corridors until further notice.
